AltamarCAM's business is fundamentally about people, and therefore, the activity of the AltamarCAM Foundation is, above all, a matter of people. When reviewing what was done in 2023, the common purpose of Partners, Trustees, and employees to build a better society stands out as the common thread. All of them, by engaging in our activity, bring to life the values of the Firm, through their generosity, commitment

and compassion. They are the soul of all that the Foundation achieves.

Their efforts feed into those of our network of allied entities: organizations that drive projects in education and health, which we support with our human, financial, organizational, and relational capabilities.

The number of entities in this network doubled in 2023. This is particularly significant when taking stock of the year, because it speaks to the reach of the Foundation and the diversity of the projects it undertakes.

This breadth of our alliance network has allowed us to multiply the number of volunteering projects and, in general, increase the opportunities we offer AltamarCAM employees to join our effort. Their response has been very positive: 84% of AltamarCAM team members in Madrid, Cologne, Barcelona, New York, Santiago de Chile, and London contributed to our projects in 2023.

In each project, we seek to achieve a clear impact, a real change in the communities in which we work: people at risk of social exclusion, young people and children in need of a boost in their education or job integration, or patients without sufficient resources to face their situation. It is essential for us to understand if we achieve the objectives of each project or not, and to what extent, as well as to analyze the efficiency of our processes to maximize our resources. For this reason, in 2023, we developed our 'Theory of Change'. This methodology, extensively tested in our environment, has allowed us to generate a series of success indicators for our key projects, which we are already monitoring in 2024, and which are helping us to improve the governance of the Foundation.

True to our mandate to leverage the Firm's capabilities, in 2023 we continued to grow our investment projects, mainly through our participation in the 'Fondo de Fundaciones' and pro-bono collaborations in Venture Philanthropy.

In a joint fundraising effort among the team, the Firm, and the Foundation, we consolidated our support for Humbi Farm, an ecological farm in Mozambique that aspires to provide sustainability to the educational center 'Munti Center', and already brings new possibilities for education, employment, and social growth to its community.

We look back with pride at how much the Firm has contributed to society this year, but also with the ambition to do more in the future. In presenting this summary of 2023, I want to express my enthusiasm for continuing to grow and improve our impact, and also share this sentiment with our network of allied entities and with all members of the AltamarCAM family, as well as with the magnificent team of the Foundation, who make the day-to-day management possible.

The Foundation's approach and organisational culture are governed by the AltamarCAM Foundation Policy¹, defined and overseen by the Board of Trustees and aligned with the principles and values that inspire the Firm

We select projects in alliance with organizations that support the most vulnerable areas of our society, acting in the fields of education and health.

By employing innovative techniques to measure the impact achieved and ensure coherence between established indicators and objectives, we present results transparently to Partners and benefactors.

During 2023, we conducted a detailed exercise focused on the 'Theory of Change' in collaboration with INUIT Foundation, with the aim of identifying and better understanding the key actors involved in our processes and their impact on the change produced by our initiatives.

This exercise allowed us to map out a series of key actions in the various stages of our projects. As a result, we have developed 22 new specific indicators that are already being monitored, to evaluate and measure the impact of our initiatives more effectively, and ensure a strategic focus aligned with our vision.



Our programs and activities are primarily focused on social action in the fields of health and education, reflecting our efforts to generate a positive impact in these areas by leveraging the capabilities of the AltamarCAM team

Our initiatives also adhere to the guidelines set by the Board of Trustees, which prioritize projects that stand out for their innovation, sustainability, impact on disadvantaged groups, excellence, participation, and impact measurement.

Following these strategic lines, we work through collaboration agreements and maintain a close relationship with the entities responsible for executing the selected projects.

During the year 2023, thanks to efficient management of the Firm's resources, both human and financial, relational, and organizational, we have increased our impact. This has been achieved by creating volunteering and participation opportunities for employees and their families to fulfil their vocation of contributing to a better world.

In 2023, we undertook eleven key projects, distributed across Madrid, Cologne, Barcelona, New York, Santiago de Chile, and Xai-Xai, directly benefiting over 3,000 people in total

Fundación Tajamar

The project aims to provide equal educational opportunities, specifically in English language learning, to the children of Colegio Tajamar, where 24% are on scholarships due to the socio-economic situation of their families. The contribution from the AltamarCAM Foundation is directed towards covering the registration fees for official English exams (such as PET) for 200 scholarship students.

Volunteering

The volunteers from AltamarCAM offer monthly English classes to 6th-grade students with the aim of helping them improve their oral expression skills, gain confidence, and prepare successfully for their official exams.

Summer School

Fundación Empieza por Educar (ExE)

The ExE Program offers professional development to young people and professionals committed to improving equal opportunities in education. The ExE Summer School takes place every July, partially funded by the AltamarCAM Foundation. Over 300 students from less privileged backgrounds receive academic and personal support for four weeks, with classes taught by 50 professionals in the process of becoming teachers and agents of change.

Volunteering

Eleven volunteers participated in the 'A Day in the Classroom' program, sharing personal experiences and challenges they have faced throughout their lives, and delivering messages that reinforce fundamental values to support the personal and professional lives of the students.

Fundación Khanimambo

AltamarCAM, our Foundation and team have joined forces in becoming a key supporter of Khanimambo's work in Praia de Xai-Xai, Mozambique: three social transformation projects supported by a sustainable cooperation model.

The Munti Center is a comprehensive social space with activities in education, nutrition and health for children, young people and adults. The Xipfundo Academy, with which AltamarCAM has been collaborating since 2019, guarantees access to higher education. Humbi is the third project, a 15hectare ecological farm with spaces for ecotourism. The farm offers sustainable, social, environmental and economic solutions to continue contributing to local development and the selfsupply of the Munti Center, driving the economic sustainability of the Khanimambo Foundation.

Action with the team: during the first quarter of 2023, a call was made to the entire global team to raise funds for the project.

Solidarity Kitchen

Asociación Norte Joven

The aim of the Norte Joven Association is to promote social development and the workforce-integration of socially disadvantaged people. The 'Solidarity Kitchen' project trains young people who wish to gain work skills (in this case in cooking) while they finish their compulsory education. At the same time, they take part in a 'Service Learning' program preparing solidarity meals that they deliver to families in disadvantaged situations, putting their learning at the service of others and generating an impact on the community.

Volunteering

Twelve members of the AltamarCAM team joined forces to volunteer at Norte Joven to train its students in financial management. The program, designed in collaboration between the AltamarCAM Foundation team and Norte Joven teachers, focused on educating students about the importance of managing their first salaries and savings. This initiative was made possible thanks to the extraordinary contribution of all the volunteers involved.







Bolsa Social to Soulem Inserción SL

On the other hand, in 2023, the AltamarCAM Foundation participated in a loan led by the Bolsa Social to Soulem Inserción SL, a social organisation that is part of the Women's Association, focused on the training and employability of vulnerable women, through emotional recovery, training in craft trades and job placement.

Pro Bono Private Equity

At the AltamarCAM Foundation, we participate in the Pro Bono Private Equity Initiative promoted by the AYO Foundation, a program that seeks to channel the specialised knowledge of private equity players towards social impact projects through the dedication of pro bono hours.



Fondo de Fundaciones in 2023

Fundación AltamarCAM is one of the founding partners of 'El Fondo de Fundaciones de Impacto S.L.', a company dedicated to channeling economic resources from foundations to companies that seek a dual objective: to have a positive social impact and to be financially sustainable in the long term.

Currently, this initiative has more than 30 shareholder foundations, and is recognised as a pioneering project and an example of cooperation between entities, which find in Fondo de Fundaciones a vehicle in which to learn the field of Venture Philanthropy.

Since the Fund's inception, we have collaborated in the selection and monitoring of the projects in which it participates. María Luisa Lombardero, a Trustee of the AltamarCAM Foundation, is a member of the Investment Committee, responsible for considering the social impact and financial viability of the companies, and for closely monitoring their progress to ensure that the objectives are met. The Fondo de Fundaciones has granted financing on preferential terms to two new social projects in 2023.





Plant on Demand

A company developing software that seeks to empower organic producers and improve the competitiveness of small producers. The aim is to accelerate the transition towards more sustainable and ethical production and consumption models, accompanying farmers in their digital transition process.

Hormiga Verde

Special Employment Centre in Extremadura that is dedicated to the circular economy through the management of electronic waste and equipment, from its collection to its recovery, also creating stable employment for 40 workers with disabilities with permanent contracts.




